He called to another coworker to call for an ambulance and checked the workers vital signs. Ben immediately began performing compressions and continued until paramedics arrived.

In June of 2008, the Ruhlin Safety Department held their annual First Aid and CPR training. Ben Neal was in attendance and used the skills he attained in an attempt to help a fellow worker. For his valiant effort, Ben received the American Red Cross Certificate of Merit. The award was presented by the Summit County American Red Cross during Ruhlin's Winter Conference.
